2/20	email Patty Sullivan	Struggling Susitna fisheries. The fisheries of the Susitna and Yentna Rivers in the Matanuska-Susitna Borough are struggling. Mat-Su Borough Assembly Member Jim Colver is the Vice Chair of the Mayor's Sportsmen's Committee. "Unless the Board of Fish mandates that conservation measures be taken, we may lose our fisheries.
