We do not want this to happen here in Talkeetna. This maintenance is not free, so we are seeking your support to secure funds for much needed work that needs to be done.

You can help. While donations of any amount are much appreciated, your family or business can support our playground by purchasing a recycled plastic lumber picket for the fence at the playground. Your support will go directly to restaining and resealing of wood equipment, 80 cubic yards of woods chips, sand box restoration, purchase and repair of broken and vandalized items and repair of the fence.
